

CNT III – Healing Harmony - Internal Muscle, Tendon, Meridian Massage – Tok Sen

Become a CNT III Trainee

Prerequisite:

- CNT I Trainee

Apply in writing for study and training

CNT III Course: Attend your first 21-hour CNT III course

Teachings of CNT III, Healing Harmony techniques including anatomy taught by a CNT III Teacher or CNT I Senior Teacher (Key CNTST1&T3)

Study textbooks:

- Chi Nei Tsang I, by Mantak Chia
- Origins of Chi Nei Tsang Energetic Opening of Body, Mind and Spirit by Mantak Chia & Josefina Reimig
- Chi Nei Tsang III, Healing Harmony - Internal Muscle, Tendon, Meridian Massage, by Mantak Chia

CNT III Course Curriculum (total 21h)

Theory: (4h)

- Anatomy
- CNT III techniques
- Healing Harmony
- Intensive muscle, tendon and meridian treatments
- Methods for cleansing intestines with herbs or hydro-colonic

Practical: (15h)

- CNT III Hands on techniques
- Exchanging CNT III massage technique with different partners
- Learn to release negative energy, to protect and cleanse yourself

Basic training: (4h)

- Iron Shirt I
- Inner Smile
- 6 Healing Sounds

Result: CNT III Trainee

Allows to collect CNT III case studies of approx. 1-hour sessions
Within 24-months collects 30 case studies. 20 can be done in a sequence of 4 x 5 sessions and 10 can be done in single sessions.

Become a CNT III Practitioner

Prerequisite:

- CNT I Practitioner
- CNT III Trainee

As a CNT III Trainee, apply in writing for study and training

CNT III course: Attend your second 21-hour CNT III course, taught by a CNT III Teacher of a CNT I Senior Teacher (Key CNTST1&T3)

Case studies: When trained with local CNT Teacher, send case studies min. 2 weeks before second CNT III training to your CNT Teacher by registered mail or scanned. For attending training with travelling CNT Teacher present on arrival of the course 30 case studies in CNT III

Extra recommended courses:

Attend a Universal Healing Tao Basic course, that includes Six Healing Sounds, Inner Smile and Iron Shirt Chi Kung I (extra 20h)

Attend a Universal Healing Tao course, that includes 3 Fires, Microcosmic Orbit and Healing Love (extra 20h)

Evaluation: CNT I Senior Teacher or CNT III Teacher, supervised by CNT I Senior Teacher (Key CNTST1&T3)

Result: Certified CNT III Practitioner

Allows you to work as a CNT III Practitioner on students and clients.

Profile as a CNT III Practitioner is added to the UHT Instructor-Directory (Key CNTP3)

Become a CNT III Teacher

Prerequisite:

- Certified Universal Healing Tao Instructor with keys BA, IS1, HL
- CNT I Teacher
- Work as a CNT III Practitioner for minimum 2 years

As a CNT III Practitioner apply in writing for

Assisting: Participate as assistant in a 21-hour CNT III course, taught by Grandmaster Chia or a CNT I Senior Teacher (Key CNTST1&T3)

Case studies: When trained with local CNT Teacher, send case studies min. 2 weeks before second CNT III training to your CNT Teacher by registered mail or scanned. For attending training with travelling CNT Teacher present on arrival of the course 100 case studies in CNT III

Evaluation: Grandmaster Chia or 2 CNT Senior I Teachers (Key CNTST1&T3)

Result: Certified CNT III Teacher

Allows to teach CNT III and evaluate CNT III students under supervision of a Senior I Teacher (Key CNTST1&T3)

UHT System will send out mailing to advertise for Teacher

If UHT System receives names/email addresses from students of Teacher
