Prerequisite: 28-hour group training in CNT I Techniques with CNT Senior Teacher or CNT I Teacher

Apply in writing for study and training

CNT III Course: Attend a CNT III group course of 21 hours (your first course in CNT III). (21h)

Teachings of CNT III, Healing Harmony techniques including anatomy taught by a CNT Senior Teacher or CNT Teacher, (Key CNTT1 & T3)

CNT III Course Curriculum

(total 21h)

Theory:

(4h)

- Anatomy
- CNT III techniques

Practical: (15h)

- CNT III Hands on techniques
- Exchanging CNT III massage technique with different partners
- Learn to release negative energy, to protect and cleanse yourself

Result: Allows to work as a CNT III Trainee for collecting case studies. Collect within 24-months 30 case studies. 20 can be done in a sequence of 4 x 5 sessions and 10 can be done in single sessions.

As a CNT III Trainee, apply in writing for study and training

CNT III course: Attend a CNT III course of 21 hours (second course in CNT III) taught by a CNT Senior Teacher or CNT Teacher,
(Key CNTST & T3)

- Origins of Chi Nei Tsang Energetic Opening of Body, Mind and Spirit by Mantak Chia & Josefine Reimig
- Chi Nei Tsang III, Healing Harmony - Internal Muscle, Tendon, Meridian Massage, by Mantak Chia

Case studies: When trained with local CNT Teacher, send case studies min. 2 weeks before second CNT III training to your CNT Teacher by registered mail or scanned. For attending training with travelling CNT Teacher present on arrival of the course a minimum of 30 case studies in CNT III.

Extra recommended courses:

Attend a Universal Healing Tao Basic course, that includes Six Healing Sounds, Inner Smile and Iron Shirt Chi Kung I (extra 24h)
A Universal Healing Tao course, that includes Microcosmic Orbit, Healing Love is recommended (extra 16h)

Evaluation: by CNT Senior Teacher or CNT III Teacher, supervised by CNT Senior Teacher

Result: Certified CNT III Practitioner

Become a CNT III Teacher

Prerequisite:

- Certified Universal Healing Tao Instructor with keys BA, IS1, HL
- CNT I Teacher
- CNT II Practitioner and CNT III Practitioner.
- CH I Practitioner
- Work as a CNT III Practitioner for minimum 2 years

As a CNT III Practitioner, apply in writing for study and training

Assisting: Participate as assistant a CNT III group course of 21 hours

Teachings of CNT III techniques including anatomy, as taught by Grandmaster Chia or a CNT Senior Teacher (21h)

Case studies: Present on arrival of the course a minimum 100 case studies in CNT III. If already CNT II Teacher case studies reduced to 50.

Evaluation: by Grandmaster Chia or 2 CNT Senior Teacher, (Key CNTST)

Result: Certification as CNT III Teacher

Allows to teach CNT III and have students and evaluate under supervision of Senior Teacher.

Become a CNT III Senior Teacher

Minimum prerequisite:

- Certified Universal Healing Tao Instructor with keys BA, IS1, HL
- CNT I, II & III Teacher
- CH I Teacher
- Work as an active CNT Teacher for minimum 3 years
- Having educated min. 6 Practitioners in level of CNT I, II or III each while you are a certified CNT I, II & III Teacher
- Showed outstanding relation and cooperation ship with UHTS

As a CNT I, II & III Teacher, apply in writing for study and training

Assisting: Participate as assistant and teach at a CNT I, II & III group course. Teachings of CNT I, II & III techniques including anatomy, as taught by Grandmaster Chia or a CNT Senior Teacher (77 h)

(Key CNTST3)
